


# My Account: How Do I Reset my Password?

- 1 Go to [admfarmview.com](http://admfarmview.com) & select **Login** at the top right OR select **My Account** from the side menu






## 2 Select **Reset it here** on the login screen

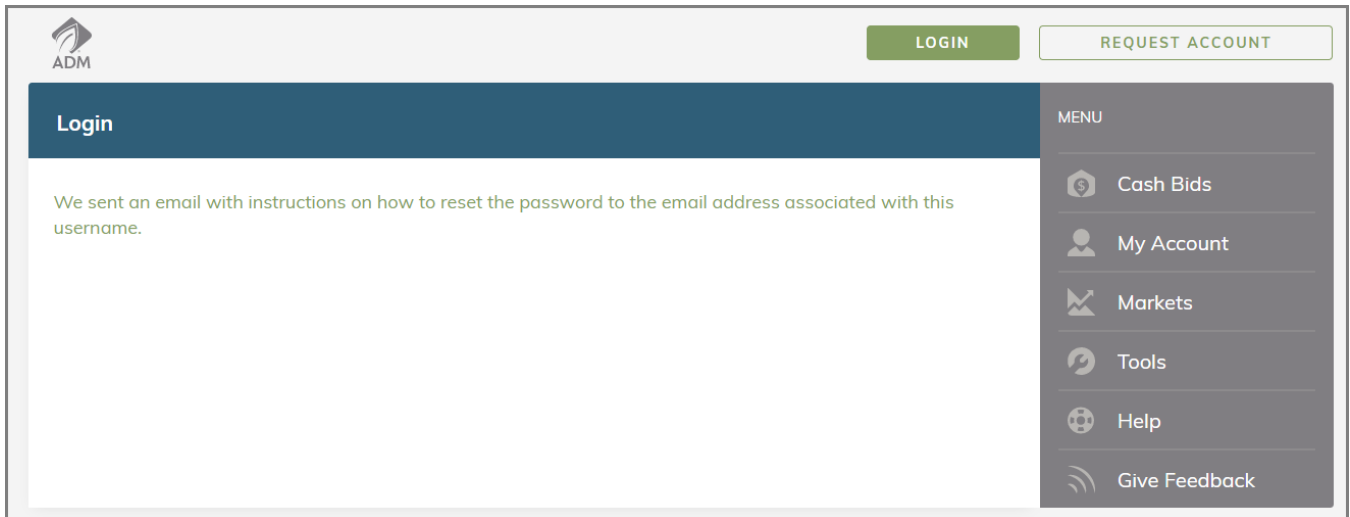
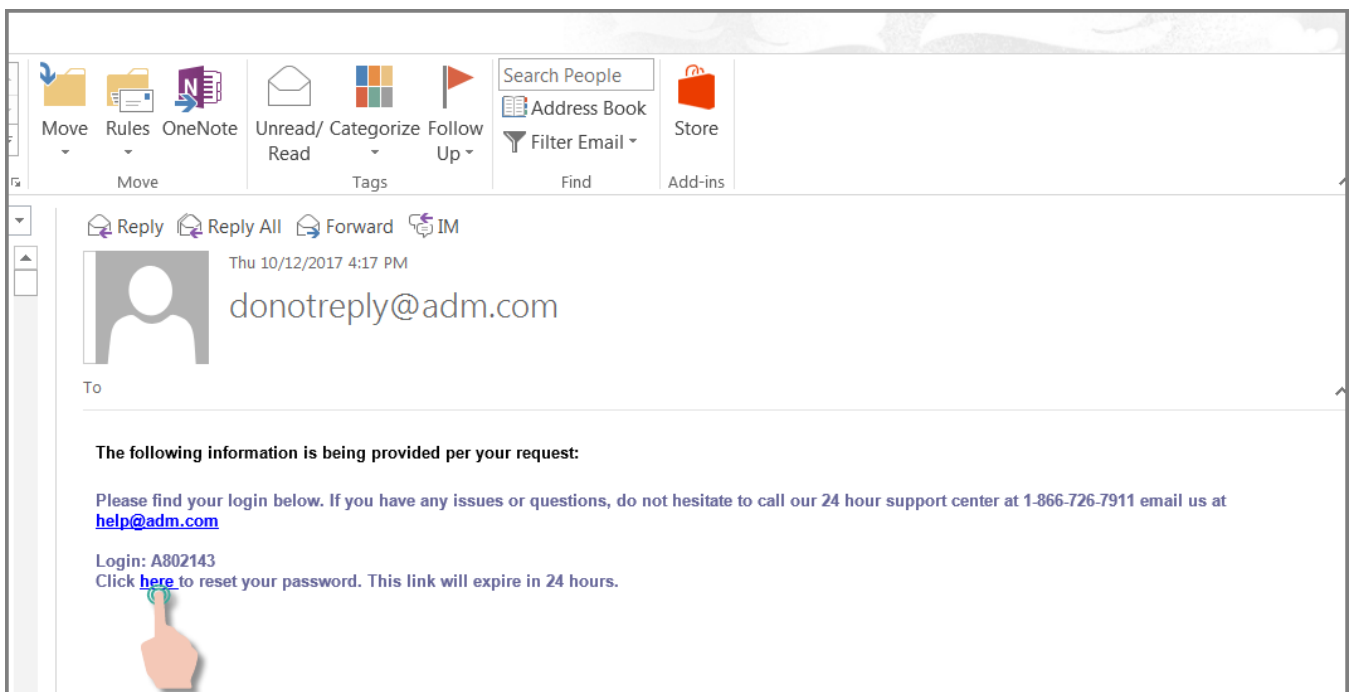

## 4 Open your email mailbox

You will have an email from 'donotreply@adm.com' with a link to reset your FarmView account password


Click [here](#), as illustrated in the image below to proceed with the reset process
