



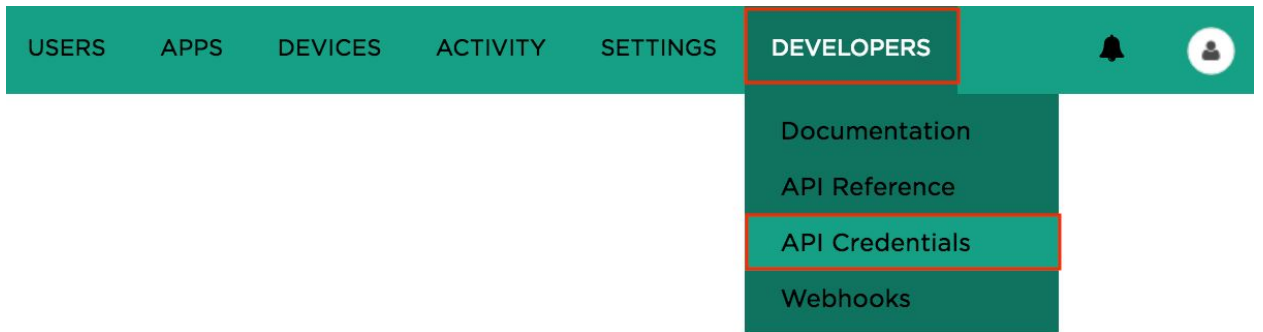

1. Login to One Login Admin account, and go to Developers > API Credentials



2. Click 'View Legacy API Key' link from the bottom of the page

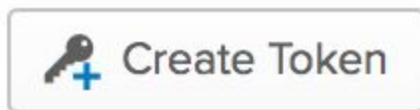
OKTA Configuration

To enable OKTA in the Launchpad, follow these steps:


1. Login to Okta Admin account, and go to security Tab then API sub tab



2. Click the Create Token button



3. Then give the Token a name and click on the Create Token:



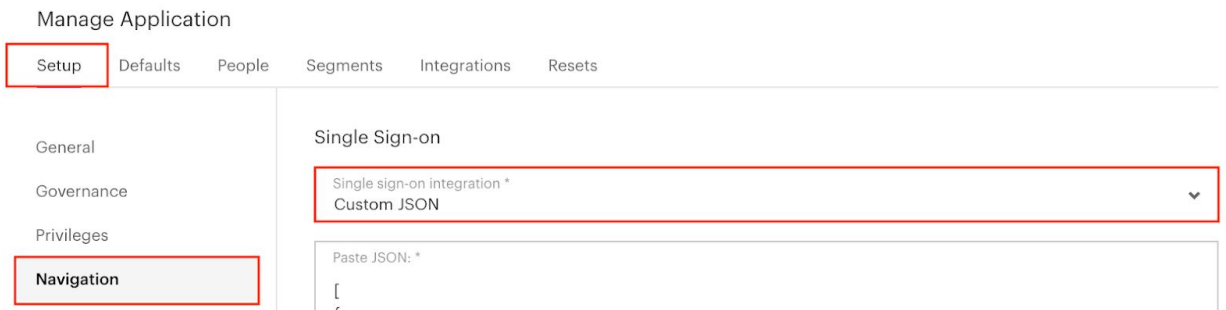
Custom JSON

To enable Custom JSON in Launchpad, following steps are to be followed:

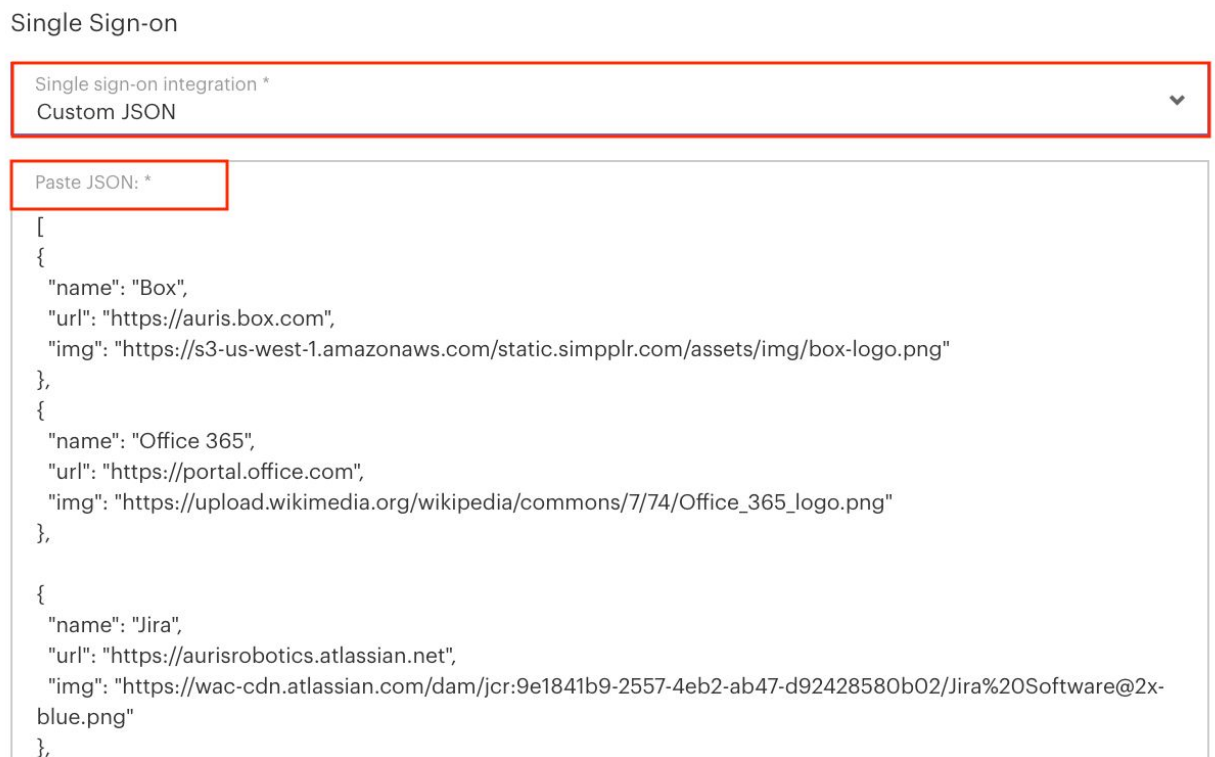
1. Login with App Manager credentials
