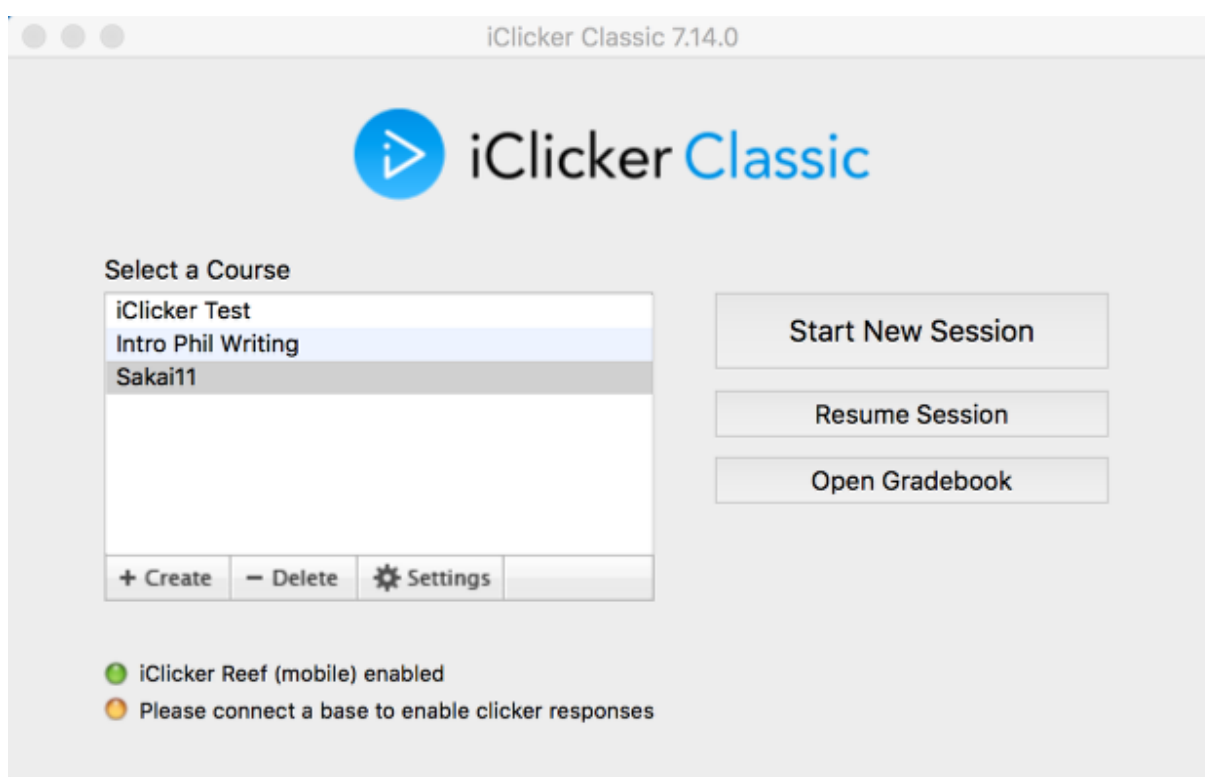


How do I use iClicker Reef (formerly known as REEF Polling) with the iClicker Classic software?

Even if you are using a base station to collect student responses you are also able to collect responses from participants who choose to use iClicker Cloud Polling.

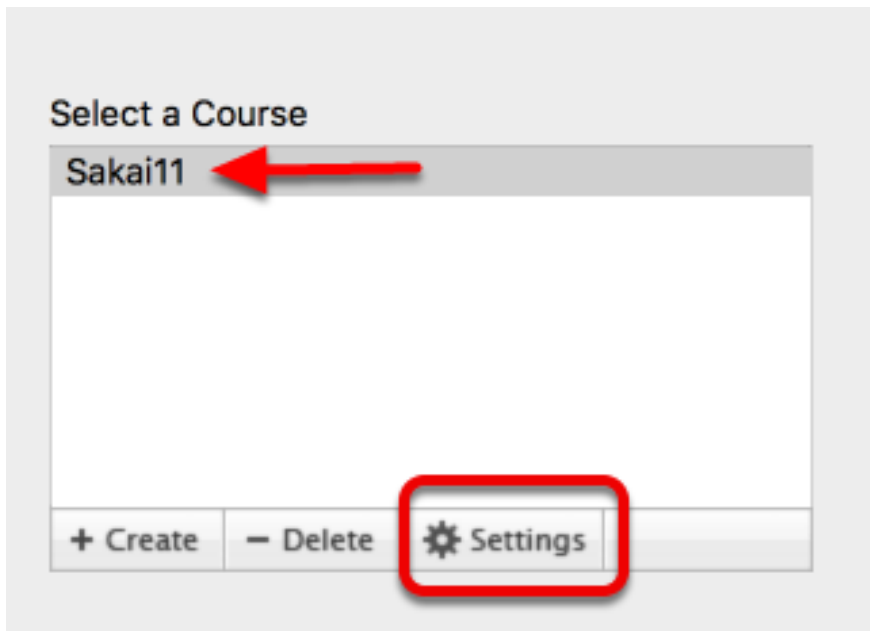
Open the Application

Launch the iClicker Classic application.



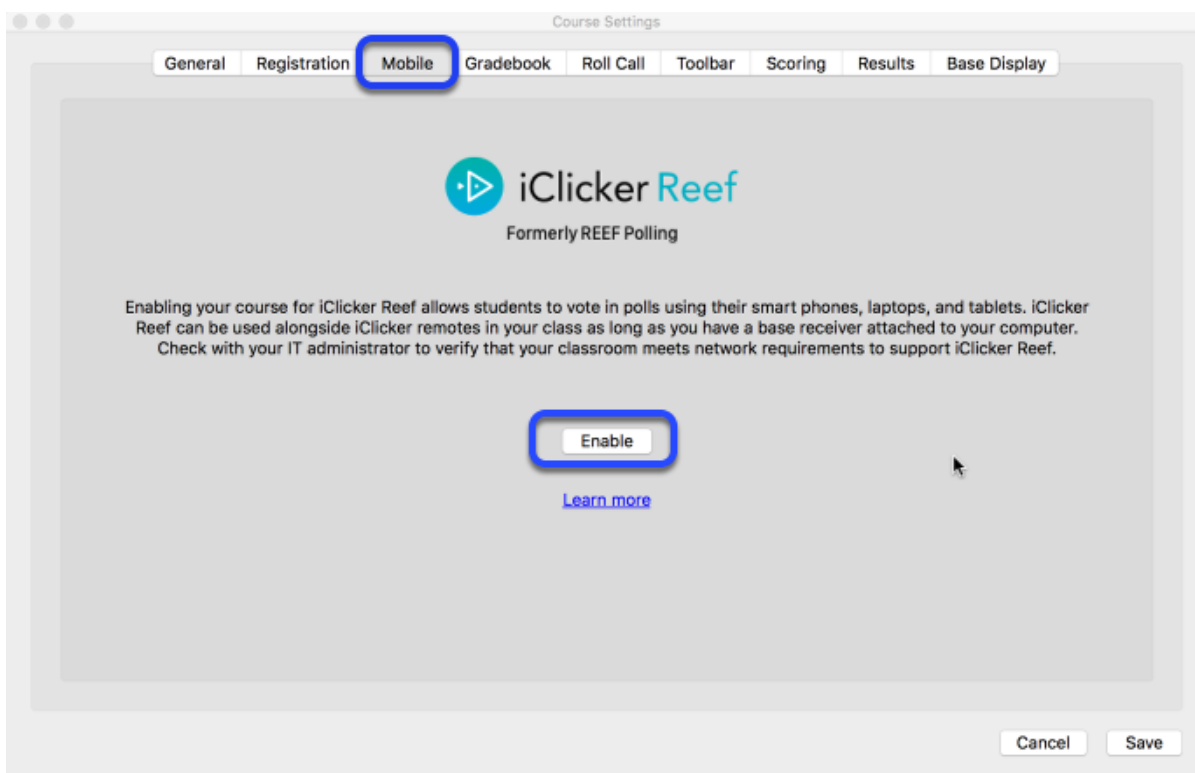
Select Course

Click on course in the list to highlight, then click "Settings"



Mobile Polling tab

Click on the Mobile Polling tab, then click "enable"

Adding Course Information

1. Institution: This information will be pre-populated with the content you entered during your account creation. However you are able to change it if necessary. As you type the name of the institution, it will display possible matches. If you do not see your school, click "Can't Find your institution?"

2. Course Discipline: This information will be pre-populated with the content you entered during your account creation. However you are able to change it if necessary.
3. Course Name: You don't have to match the name in Sakai exactly but the more similar it is, the easier it will be for your students to find the course when the time comes to register.
4. Start/End Date: Choose the correct start/end date for your course.
5. Screenshots: Select when you wish your students to see screenshots of the question you are displaying.
6. Optional section: None of the information entered in this section is required, however, the more information you provide, the easier it will be for your students to select your course in the application.
7. Click Create

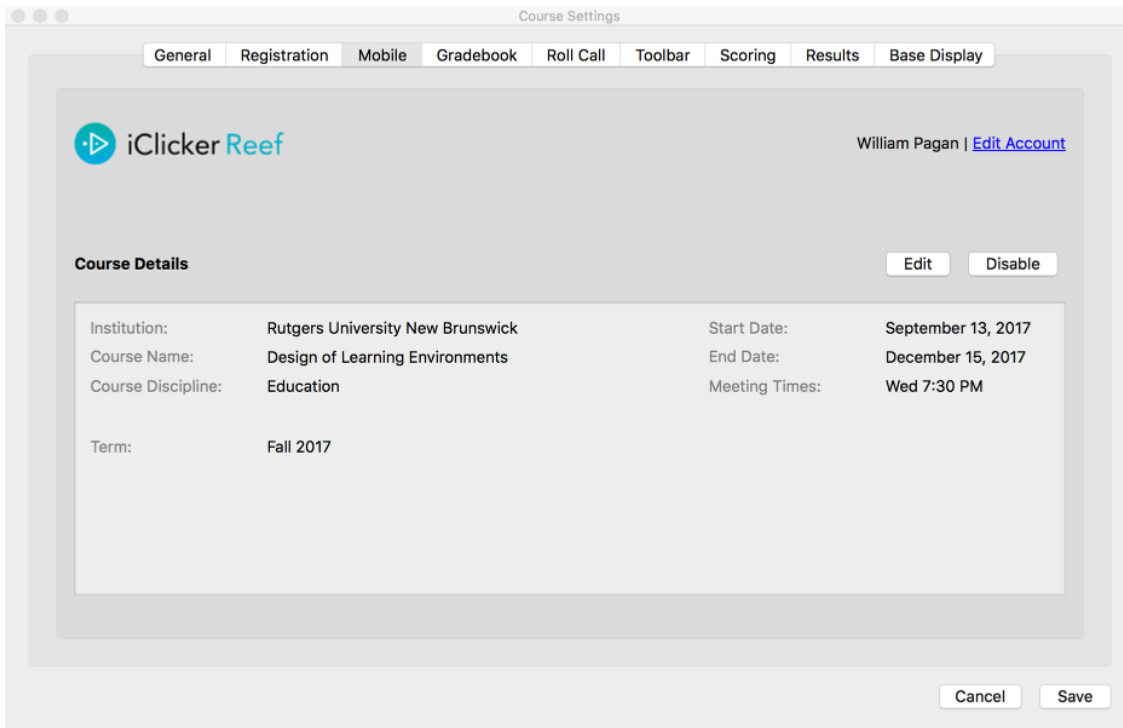

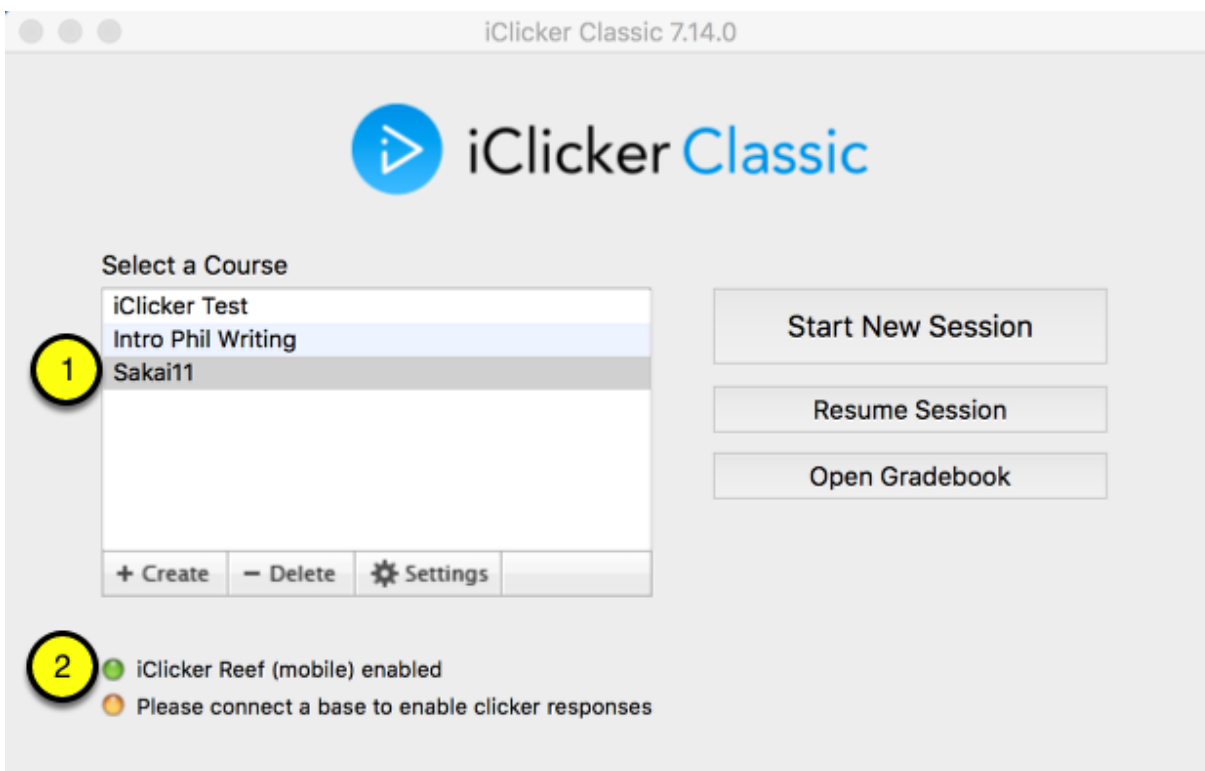
